Justification for Sole Source Procurement

The procurement process for this contract was conducted in compliance with established competitive procurement procedures. A Request for Proposals (RFP) was distributed to a list of qualified potential bidders. Several vendors requested and received the RFP packet; however, despite the open and competitive opportunity provided, only one vendor submitted a final proposal by the established deadline.

Because the procurement process was competitive and all interested parties were given the opportunity to respond, the receipt of a single proposal does not indicate a lack of competition, but rather that no other vendors chose to submit. In such cases, the procurement is considered a sole source by circumstance, not by design. Awarding the contract to the single responsive and responsible bidder is therefore justified, as the process was conducted fairly, openly, and in alignment with federal and state procurement standards.


