SUBJECT Co-Enrollment and Co-Funding

PURPOSE

To allow Co-Enrollment and Co-Funding for WIOA Title I services and partner agencies

BACKGROUND

Under WIOA, the ages for youth and adult overlap and allows for participants to be co-enrolled into two separate WIOA programs such as In-School Youth and Adult if eligible and there is a need for specific services. The same shall apply to Out-of-School Youth. Eligibility guidelines must be followed for each program in which the participant is enrolled.

FUNDING

Local programs must identify and track the funding streams which pay the costs of for the services provided to individual who are participating in concurrent programs to ensure program funds are spent on services allowed for specific provisions. Career Specialists shall be responsible for recording the time to the appropriate funding stream.

Co-Funding and Co-Enrollment also applies to leveraging services between partner agencies and it is recommended that local areas ensure that partners are not duplicating services, such as WIOA and Career Pathways both paying for fuel for a participant.

To address this issue NCAWDB, will require proof from other agencies of what funding the participant is receiving.
